# EDUCATION

## Formal Education

Suraj Miani is considered as the main area where people have strong believe in sectarianism (Shia, Sunni ).There are two school one for girls and one for boys. Due to sectarianism girls and small kids have to face problems because atmosphere in the school was not favorable. Cool minded people were worried to send their children to school second problem for girls was that there was no science teacher in local girls school. ROSHNI head office is also situated in the same area. So ROSHNI felt this situation and took a step for social harmony and think for the establishment of such an institute where no one discuss religion or sect. So in year 2007 Roshni started a school up to matriculation Brook field Public School in VIP Colony Suraj Miani. In this school every student belonging to any religion or sect gets education freely. Now science students have a facility and they are attracted to this school.



## Non-Formal Education

Multan is a cultural city where people are very rigged and believe on outworn customs and rites. They consider very awkward if girls get education. In rural areas people are living in scattered localities and in every Basti or Moza have no school in every locality. Girls observed parda and they are not allowed to go far away from their houses. After survey ROSHNI decided to establish home schools with community participation. ROSHNI conduct meetings with community elaborate their procedure and identified 13 places for home schools in 13 different localities.

ROSHNI adopt following method to start home schools. After identification of teacher and place Roshni invited a local landlord or well off personality of the area for opening a school. Initially total cost was Rs. 2250/ School for children. In inaugurated ceremony of school landlord bear expenses. So in this was Roshni arranged 13 opening ceremony functions. Community



demand increased gradually and ROSHNI conduct survey of Tehsil Sadar Multan. ROSHNI received 235 applications for non-formal home schools from different areas where teachers were willing to offer their services Then ROSHINI send request to prime minister Literacy Commission for 200 schools but unfortunately PMLC allocated only 50

schools for this area. ( Suraj Miani, Binda Sandeela, Alamdi Surrah, Nawab Pur, Gray Wala, Salah Mahey, Ghamoon Wala, Rangeel Pur, Chowk Shah Abass, Basti Langrial, Qasm Bela, Mohd Pur Ghoti and Muzafarabad) Mr Ch. Sajjad Haider (Research Officer) visited the site for verification. After teacher's selection ROSHNI organized teacher's training of 15 days then 50 schools started work. Village education Committees (VECs) were formed in every school. It was consisted of student's parents, Retired teachers, councilors and representatives of community. The responsibilities of VEC are look after, enrolment, dropout and conduct the meeting with ROSHNI staff.

UNDP launched PLUS programme in Multan and ROSHNI was the single organization that signs the MOU with UNDP, organized teachers training and execute the home schools in Slums areas and Katch abadies. (Shah Shamas, islam Pura, Shah Faisla Colony, Tareen Colony, Gulnar Colony, Ghous Abad, Amirabad, Bukhari Colony, Mohala Mahagreen, Rasool Pura Sakhi Sultan). After one year these schools become self sustain. Now ROSHNI is establishing community based home schools with community collaboration. In 2010 under LPP 20 schools were established in Multan.

## **Awareness Campaign**

### **EDUCATION AWARENESS PROGRAMME**

ROSHNI Organization planned an Awareness Programme in collaboration with Govt. Rifa-e-Aam high school Multan in rural areas of Multan. Where people are living very miserable life and there is lack of education. ROSHNI selected 25 villages of District Multan and District Khanewal.

After dividing areas in sections, Roshni planned to visit each area by one of the five groups. One student was group leader and one was Assistant group leader. Roshni negotiated with Numbered approximately one week before the visit. Group visited the area for two days. Numberdar was responsible for collecting the community people at one place. Roshni and community people will arrange for the accommodation of the group for one night. Every group reached in the village at Thursday evening. Every group conducted three sessions in one village first session was conducted on Thursday night, second at Friday morning and third after Namaz-e-Juma and than they will come back at Friday evening. Every session was consisted on speeches and role-play.

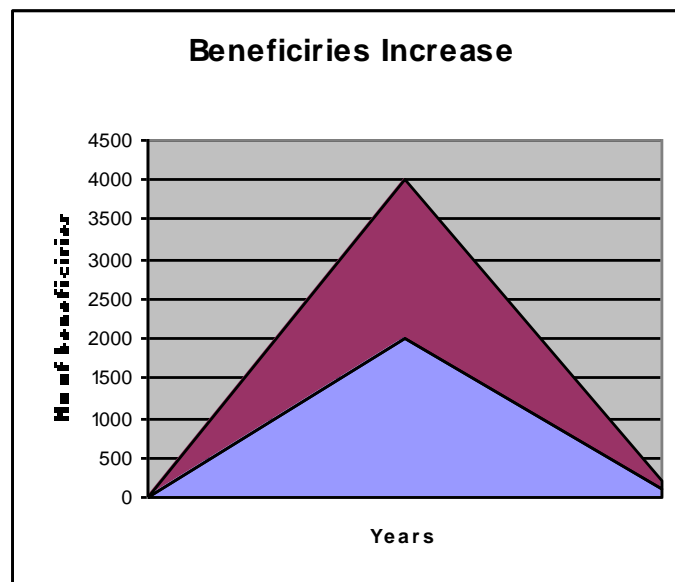
Chairman of ROSHNI and Programme Coordinator visited every area at night and participated in the sessions. Average of 30 to 40 persons attended every session. Government of Pakistan recognized this programme and awarded the Iqra Medal to Chairman of ROSHNI (Ch.Abdussalam) and gave Silver stars to the leader of the programme. Total 75 sessions were conducted and 3725 person attended these sessions.

## Book Bank

ROSHNI was working on education since 1992, the community of its area is poor and they cannot or do not spend money on their children especially on girls for education. During the survey and visits and community meeting the main issue comes forward that is poverty. It is their lame excuse that they are live hand to mouth and cannot afford the expenditure of education. They cannot pay fee. ROSHNI solved their problem of fee in shape of home schools. The next problem was purchase of books. The books were very necessary for them. ROSHNI was not in a position to buy book for them. The executive body of ROSHNI decided to establish Book Bank in its head office for needy and poor students. Mr. Muhammad Anwar Shamin (Councilor Halqa # 95) inaugurated the Book Bank. Where poor students get desired school colleges and university books. Initially Chairman of Organization wrote the letters to the head of he institutes for depositing the books in ROSHNI Book Bank. The procedure set the ROSHINI for getting Books was very easy transparent. ROSHINI designed a form individual submitted the other method was very easy who deposited this book of previous class he is illegible to get book for next class. This exercise is still continued and hindered of beneficiaries are getting benefit from Book bank

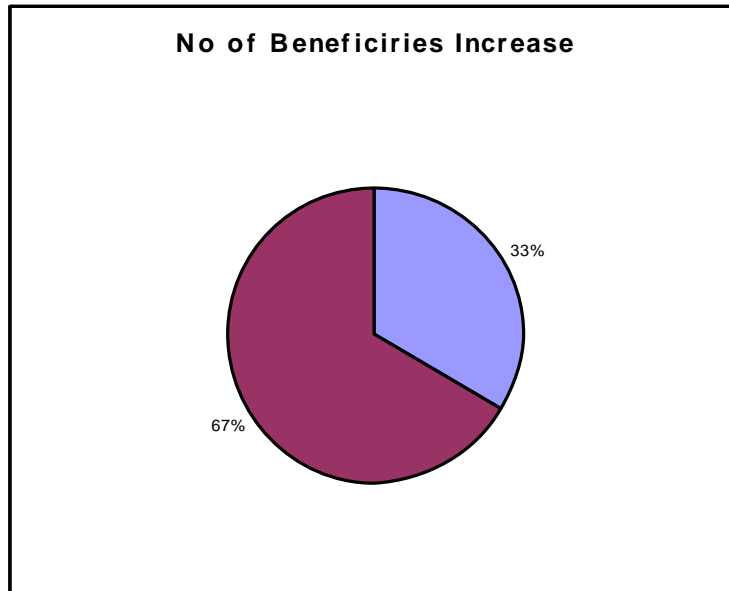


## Library
